Prize:	Full conference registration, return economy airfares, A\$500 plus a copy of Dr Milton Lewis' two-volume book on the history of public health medicine in Australia, " <i>The People's Health: Volume 1 Public Health in Australia 1788 – 1950 and Volume 2 Public Health in Australia 1950 – Present</i> "
Open to:	AFPHM Advanced Trainees and new Fellows within one year of sitting their Final Program Assessment examination.
Criteria:	Regional Committees in the Australian States and Territories, and in New Zealand are asked to select an AFPHM advanced trainee to make a presentation on a piece of their own work at the RACP Congress the following year. Regional Committees are encouraged to send a different trainee each year and no trainee will be awarded the prize twice. New Fellows may be nominated to participate in the competition within one year of sitting their Final Program Assessment examination. The trainee presentations are limited to 10 minutes with 2-5 minutes for questions. The presentations are judged by a panel of three senior AFPHM Fellows.
